

**Least Tern:** In Florida, least terns have been banded primarily from roof-top colonies in the Tampa Bay area through a joint Audubon Florida - Eckerd College Project. Federal metal bands and combination of color-bands were placed on fallen chick before they were returned to the roof-tops. Some least terns from throughout their range are marked with plastic field readable alpha-numeric bands. For least terns with alpha-numeric coded bands, see the table below for reporting information.
