

Red Knot: To report Red Knots, go to bandedbirds.org. For many species banded with an alpha-numeric or character code, like Red Knots, you can map the code instantly and see the banding origin and resight history.

Flags usually have 3-digit alpha-numeric or character code. Light green and dark green flagged red knots are most frequently observed in Florida. These represent individuals banded in the United States. You may see colored other colored flags, where the color represents the country of origin. If your Red Knot has	Banding Origin
Blue Flag	Brazil or Paraguay
Green Flag (dark green or light green)	United States
Orange Flag	Argentina or Uruguay
Red Flag	Canada, breeding
Yellow Flag	Bolivia, Ecuador, or Peru
White Flag	Canada
